

Innovations Academy Traffic Flow Plan

For those parents who wish to stay in their vehicle and drive up to drop off or pick up their children, there are two loading zones for this purpose, both denoted by a white curb that says "Loading Zone." If you enter the campus at the traffic signal, you'll turn left and go past the front of the school all the way down to the white curb. (Stopping is not allowed in the fire lane denoted by a red curb or in the crosswalks). There is a pedestrian gate where the students can enter the school near this loading zone or they can choose to walk back to the main entrance of the school. If you'd prefer to be able to drop off and pick up closer to the main entrance, please enter the campus ½ block south of the main entrance. This driveway goes through a small parking lot in a park and leads to our largest loading zone, which is directly in front of the Kindergarten/1st Grade playground. Please remember to pull forward when space becomes available. If the line of vehicles becomes too long, you may need to find a parking spot. Be sure to let your children know where you plan to pick them up so they can wait for you in the appropriate area.

If you need to get out of your vehicle to escort a child, drop something off, volunteer at school, speak to a teacher, etc., you'll need to find a spot in the parking lot. Parking is never allowed in the loading zone (white curb) or the fire lane (red curb). Occasionally the school's parking lots will be completely full due to district meetings being held on our campus; when this happens you can try to find a spot in the dirt lot at the northeast end of the campus or use street parking on N. Brookville Drive. There will be 10 parking spots in the front row of the main lot reserved for IA families--these spots will have an orange traffic cone marked "I.A." in them. (Please don't run over the cone by driving forward when you leave!)

Red curb - Fire Lane	No Stopping any time; do not drop off or pick up students
White curb - Loading Zone	Drop off and pick up OK--no unattended vehicles
Parking Lot	To be used anytime a vehicle is left unattended
