

### **Human Sexuality Lesson 3: Male Puberty, Anatomy, Physiology**

Objective: Engage students in a hands-on activity that will introduce and/or enhance understanding of the three-dimensional structures, functions, and relationships of the organs and tissues of the male urogenital tract.

Materials:

- Cork board
- Pins
- Two grapes = Testes (male gonads)
- One red bell pepper (bottom half) = Scrotum
- Six to eight pipe cleaners (various colors) to represent several structures:
  - Epididymis (2)
  - Vas deferens a.k.a. Ductus deferens (2)
  - Ejaculatory ducts (2)
- One lime = Prostate
- Two strawberries = Seminal vesicles
- One yellow squash (cut to average size, 3 ½ inches long) = Penis (male phallus), flaccid
- One banana (cut to average size, 6 inches long) = Penis (male phallus), erect
- Two lemons = Kidneys
- Three pipe cleaners (or pieces of flexible tubing) = Ureters and urethra
- One orange = Bladder
